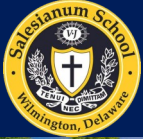

赛西纳姆高中Salesianum School建于1903年，是一所很独特的天主教男生中学，位于特拉华州威名顿市，处于宾州、新泽西州和特拉华州交界的三角区，环境优美，交通方便。学校被授予“全美前50的天主教学校”。学校有6个网球场、2个棒球场、2个足球场、1个足球训练场、1个曲棍球场，活动场地包括跳高、跳远、撑杆跳高、铅球等设施。学校拥有优秀的师资力量，75名优秀教师和30名专业管理人员，约2/3的教师已获得硕士学位，平均教学经验近23年，他们为学生创建一个展现自己的才华和个性的独特学习环境。学校设有多门文学、数学、科学、社会学课程，以培养未来的大学生为宗旨，造就全面发展的人才。2011年毕业生平均获得了\$48,952美元的奖学金，SAT平均高于全美平均分，40%的学生取得1800分以上的成绩。
