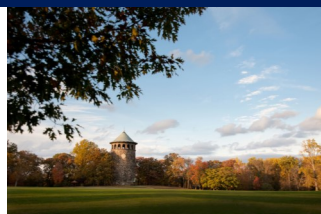




Tower Hill School

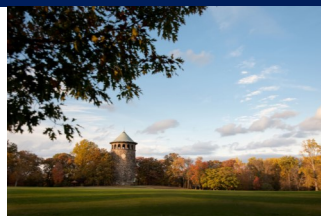
